

Realistic alternatives and material support changed a mother's mind.


Staring down at the positive pregnancy test in her hands, Mariana felt torn. She had always dreamed of being a mom one day, once she had a good job and was married. But Mariana was young and just wasn't ready to have a baby. She didn't know if her boyfriend was father material, but she suspected he wouldn't be there when she needed him.

The idea of providing for herself and her baby on her own seemed impossible.

Unsure of what to do or who to turn to. Mariana began researching online about her abortion options at 18 weeks. While searching, she came across the phone number for Pregnancy Decision Line (PDL). Mariana called, hoping to find someone who would care and give her some advice. The coach who answered her call was gentle and professional. Mariana immediately felt more at ease. "I have nothing to offer a child" she confided in the coach, "and my boyfriend just isn't ready to be a dad."

The coach took the time to listen to Mariana voice her fears. She explained the many options Mariana had available to her and shed light on the various ways a local pregnancy center could help Mariana prepare for motherhood. Her local center could provide a free ultrasound, parenting classes, and baby items

Unborn or Preborn?

As someone in the pro-life movement, you've probably seen the terms "unborn" and "preborn" used to describe children in the womb. As you've supported Care Net, you've probably also noticed that we use the term "unborn."

We use "unborn" for a few reasons. The most straightforward reason is that it appears in dictionaries, including medical dictionaries, while "preborn" generally doesn't. "Unborn" is a word that carries the weight of legitimacy and medical accuracy, while "preborn" is a word more recently created by the pro-life movement.

Secondly, because preborn is a "new" word, it doesn't carry the same history and tradition as the ancient word "unborn," which first appeared in the 12th century. Throughout the history of the pro-life movement, the word "unborn" has been used to describe babies in the womb, and thus carries with it the heritage of the pro-life heroes who have toiled for years to defend precious unborn lives.

And this leads to the most important reason Care Net uses the word "unborn." Care Net seeks to engage in productive, God-honoring dialogue with both pro-life and pro-choice people. Our aim is to educate, inspire, and hopefully transform hearts and minds to love and care for the unborn and their parents. But nothing shuts down this kind of dialogue more quickly than coming across as "biased" or having an "agenda." Because "preborn" is a word that was created by the pro-life movement, it carries with it the danger that only an "activist" would use it, not a "regular person."

Whether this accusation is true or not, we want to stick to the traditional "unborn," so we don't end conversations before they even get started. Think about it this way – if someone called you antichoice (which is a word that was made up by the pro-choice movement to disparage pro-life people), would you think they were looking for a productive conversation with you? Words matter, and we want to choose our words wisely (Proverbs 18:21).

We understand why some people may want to use the word "preborn," but I wanted to make sure you understood why we still say "unborn."


But none of that happens without committed pro ABUNDANT life people who daily pray, serve, and give on behalf of the babies at risk for abortion.


